DR. DAMIAN WOJCIK

Dr. Damian Wojcik will discuss treatment options and clinical outcomes in relation to improvements in QOL and longevity. In addition he will present dramatic unpublished New Zealand cases.

Dr DAMIAN WOJCIK graduated from Auckland Medical School, New Zealand, in 1979. Damian is a Family Physician, Clinical Metal Toxicologist, and Forensic Physician. In 2001 he founded the Northland Environmental Health Clinic (NEHC) to explore a path to Integrative Medicine by combining spirituality, art, philosophy, and scientific research with compassionate service to his patients. NEHC has adopted a model of healthcare that not only treats symptoms, but also seeks out and where possible remedies the underlying nutritional and environmental causes of illness.

Dr Wojcik has particular expertise in human mercury toxicology, and as a clinician researcher has co-authored two published papers in this field. He has a post graduate Fellowship in Nutrition and Environmental Medicine from the Australasian College of Nutrition and Environmental Medicine (ACNEM), and as a Forensic Physician has 22 years experience as a police medical officer. Current areas of active research are in metal toxicology, agricultural spray toxicity, nutritional medicine for cancer patients, and the biological effects of non-ionizing radiation (RFR) with a particular focus on brain tumours.
