Fees Conditions:

- The cost of course tuition is met by tuition fees and government funding
- As required, fees paid are held in a Trust Fund
- No Student shall graduate unless all fees and other costs have been paid in full
- Course fees do not include textbooks and course related materials or equipment. Full time students should allow approximately \$1200 per year for books and other course related expenses.
- Students who change their mode of learning for a course from on-line to on-campus, or vice versa, will be charged a \$50 administration fee per course.

Student Loans & Allowances – for Domestic Student only

SPCNM's programmes are NZQA approved therefore students are eligible for Student Loans through Studylink. *Note: students who study full-time are eligible for student allowances and course related costs. Note:

- *To be eligible for a Student Allowance or Student Loan you must be a New Zealand citizen. If you're not a New Zealand citizen you must be ordinarily resident in New Zealand and meet one of the following residence requirements:*
- *have been entitled to reside indefinitely in New Zealand under the Immigration Act 2009 for at least 3 years and have been living in New Zealand for at least 3 years **or** be a refugee or protected person and be entitled to reside indefinitely in New Zealand under the Immigration Act 2009 **or** sponsored into New Zealand by a family member who holds refugee status or protected person status.*
