**EXTRACT FROM: RULES of
THE SOUTH PACIFIC COLLEGE OF NATURAL MEDICINE INC. (“The College”)**

5.2 Qualifications for Membership

- i) Membership is hereby automatically conferred on those persons who were members on or before 18th of March 2004.
- ii) The following persons shall be eligible to make application for membership of the College:
 - a) Graduates of The College;
 - b) Natural therapists who are members of an association recognized and approved by the Board of the College;
 - c) Persons who, in the opinion of the Board of the College, are fit and proper persons to be members of the College.
- iii) A person shall become a member on approval of their application to become a member by the Board of the College.
- iv) An applicant for membership shall complete such form of application for membership as the Board of the College shall from time to time provide and the application form shall have endorsed thereon, the signatures of a proposer and seconder, both of whom shall be existing members of the College. The applicant shall provide a Curriculum Vitae together with the completed application form as aforesaid and the application for membership will be considered by the Board of the College at the next Board meeting following the date of the application.

5.3 On approval by the Board of the College, the applicant shall become a member of the College.

5.4 Every Member, Distinguished Fellow and Friend of the College shall advise the Board of any change of address.

5.5 The Board shall keep a membership register of members recording their names and addresses and the dates each member became a member.

5.6 All members (and Board members) shall promote the interests and the objects of the College and shall do nothing to bring the College into disrepute.

6 Subscriptions

6.1 The annual subscription shall be set by resolution of the Board of the College and will be due for payment no later than the 31st day of March in each and every year.

7 Cessation of Membership

7.2 The Board of the College shall be entitled to cancel membership of a Member if:-
