### **Fees Terms & Conditions**

- All fees include GST.
- Bachelor of Natural Medicine and New Zealand Diploma in Holistic Nutrition applicants must pay an enrolment application fee after their documents are processed, and they are invited to an interview. Payment details will be provided, and interviews are scheduled upon receipt of payment.
- No application fee applies to the New Zealand Certificate in Study and Employment Pathways - Natural Medicine or Certificate of Personal Interest programmes.
- Student Services Fees are set annually in consultation with the Student Council within
  Tertiary Education Commission guidelines.
- All course fees and Student Services Fees must be paid in full and in advance for each academic year.
- A fees invoice will be emailed once enrolment in a new programme is confirmed and annually thereafter.
- Students must arrange one of the following payment methods by the invoice due date:
  - Student Loan funding (available to eligible domestic students only, not available for Certificate of Personal Interest courses).
  - Bank transfer (international transfers must cover bank charges).
  - Credit card (at reception only, surcharge applies).
- Course fees do not include textbooks, materials, or equipment. See Required Textbooks & Course Equipment List provided with the Offer of Place for more information.
- For full terms and conditions, refer to <u>SPCNM Admissions and Enrolment Terms & Conditions</u> and the *Student Acknowledgement* provided with the *Offer of Place*.

#### **Refund Policy**

- There will be no refunds provided for withdrawals from a course or programme after two weeks (14 calendar days) from the semester start date.
- Refunds will be provided for withdrawals from a course or programme in the first two weeks (14 calendar days) following the semester start date. There will be an administration fee for withdrawals, within this period, of 10% of course fees/Student Services Fees.
- Students who withdraw from a course or programme before the semester start date will be provided with a 100% refund of course fees/Student Services Fees.
